The outdoor settings that make up the project will be fitted out with some of the companies' best sellers, and they will spring to life in the public areas in front of the Incoronata Library, a historic and cultural landmark of the city. An open-air salon, decked out with sofas and sunshades, will welcome the public and be the location for encounters with the students of Milan Polytechnic.

Through an interconnecting green space, the trail will continue into the Sala degli Archi, a stylish backdrop for an assortment of products from the collection, proposed afresh by 967arch with new, nuanced combinations of colors materials. It will be an opportunity to get up close and appreciate the choice and the quality of the materials, and the attention to detail and finish. On the occasion of Milano Design Week, the floor of the hall will be covered with a parquet from the Family collection by Florian, Fim & Coro's main sponsor in this initiative; a combination of materials that will enhance the products on display in an elegant and welcoming environment.

The trail concludes in the magical atmosphere of the little cloister with its central garden. In this idyllic blend of nature and design, guests will be able to enjoy a relaxing break in calm contemplation, far from the frenzy of the Fuorisalone, cocooned in the soothing atmosphere of the architectural complex which, at sunset, is rendered even more evocative by the luminous Plant umbrella, immersed in the greenery of the cloister.

The dialogue with the public and private context in which the exhibition unfolds is then enriched by another contribution: the presence of sculptures by the Danish artist Misja Rasmussen, who, fascinated by the spaces of the Incoronata, has chosen to enter into a dialogue with the architecture and furnishings through a selection of his works.

The Fim and Coro installation is more than a simple display of their collections; it is an opportunity to discover, spend time, and relax in a historic corner of the city that is little known, even by locals. It is an experience that, in addition to showing how outdoor spaces can become comfortable and elegant living milieus, also transforms into a journey of discovery amid contemporary aesthetics and historical contexts.

The exhibition will be punctuated by a calendar of interviews curated by the well-known journalist Giorgio Tartaro. These events will feature industry professionals and students of Milan Polytechnic, creating a dynamic and stimulating dialogue that will explore the new frontiers of outdoor design.

This opportunity for involvement and exchange of ideas will further enhance the overall experience, offering an in-depth and all-round vision of the world of outdoor design and providing points for reflection for enthusiasts, industry experts, and emerging creative minds.
